

I usually don't read stories that involve forbidden love, so I was a little hesitant to read Did I Mention I Love You?, but in the end I'm glad that I did because it led me to Estelle Maskame. This story was interesting for the most part, I found it to be a bit predictable at times but I find that in a lot of contemporary stories so it didn't really bother me. I read contemporary stories for the journey the characters take, and I generally enjoy ones that involve love and soul searching in high school - and this book had that. I've read some reviews where people wanted more parental presence, or how it didn't seem real that this was a normal high school experience - but I completely related to all of it. The characters range from 16-18 years old, and we see them do nothing but party during summer break. This was high school to me - I saw all the parties, drugs,

I really liked Eden, I mean girl had her flaws but overall she was very relatable. She's a very complex character - having to deal with the strain from her parent's divorce, insecurities, and anxiety from being in a new city for the summer, all while trying to be herself still.
