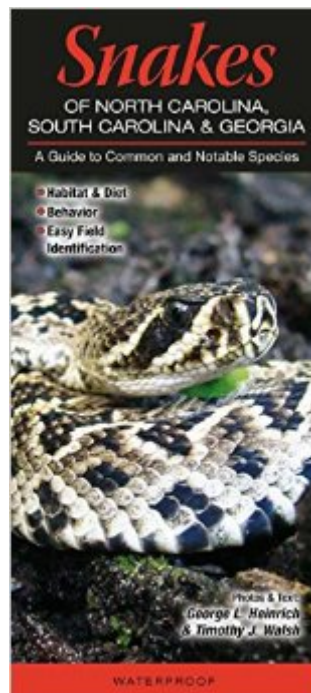

We have a few snakes that have recently come out of hiding in our back yard and this guide has been perfect for identifying what they are and whether or not they are poisonous. I keep it very handy for those times I need to run in the house and identify another snake.

My family often goes on hikes in the mountains in Georgia but we know nothing about snakes. Every once and a while we would see one while we were on the trail and didn't know if it was poisonous or not. This pullout was a great solution. It is laminated, about 4 pages with color pictures. Now we just throw this in our backpacks and pull it out any time we see a snake. It is fun for the boys to try to identify the type of snake. Two thumbs up.
