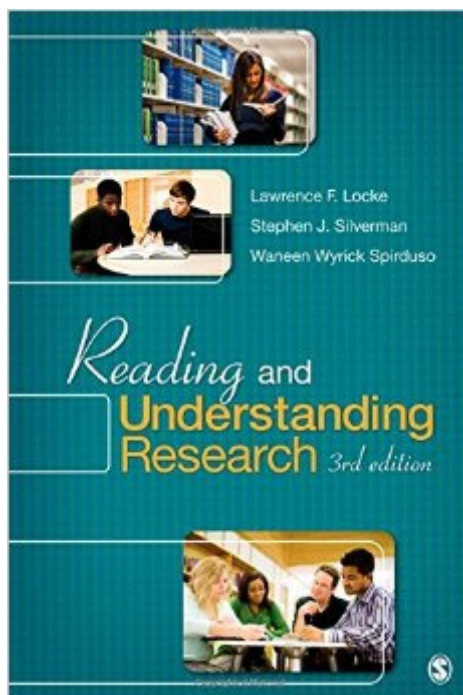

Even for the novice, I dare say the authors could make this work far more concise; way too many words used to say simple things and far too much repetition of simple ideas.
