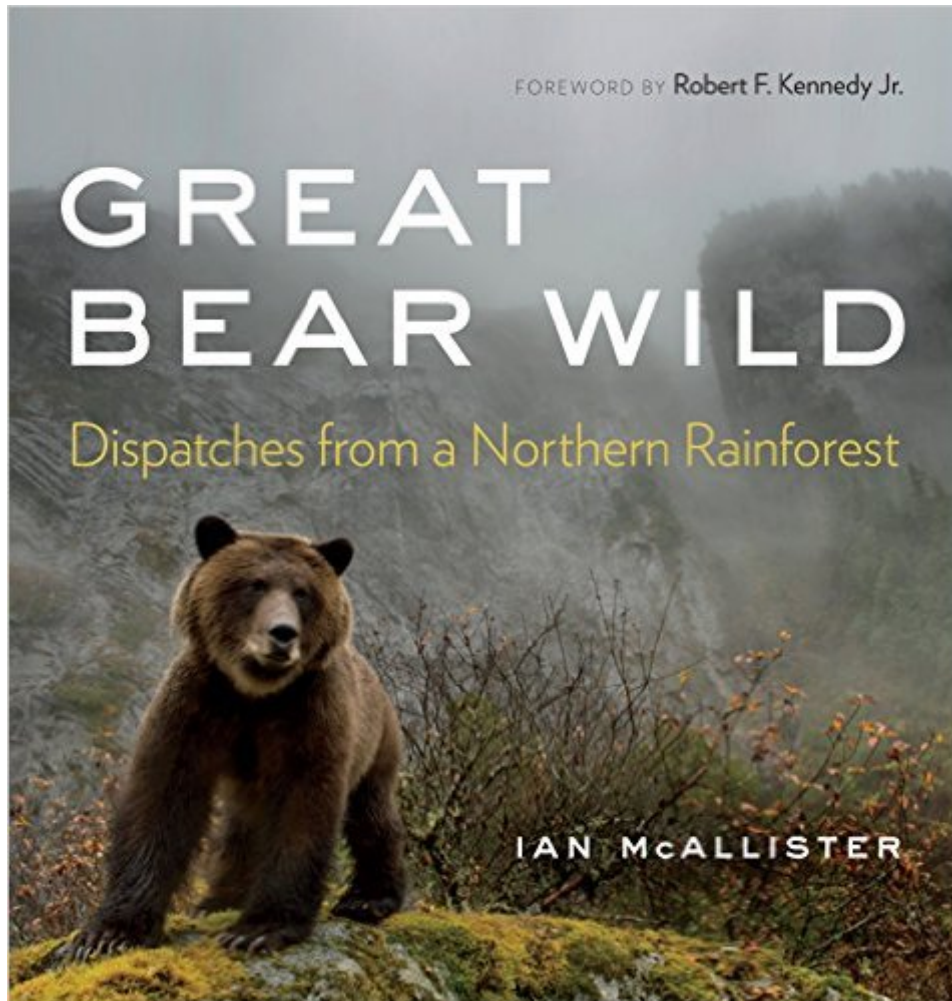

Synopsis

Along the way, we meet the spectacular wildlife that inhabits the Great Bear Rainforest. In a not-so-unusual day, McAllister quietly observes twenty-seven bears fishing for salmon, three of which are the famed pure white spirit bear. McAllister introduces us to the First Nations people who have lived there for millennia and have become his close friends and allies, and to the scientists conducting groundbreaking research and racing against time to protect the rainforest from massive energy projects. Rich with full-color photographs of the wolves, whales, and other creatures who make the rainforest their home, *Great Bear Wild* is a stunning celebration of this legendary area.
